Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

This coming Lord's Day we will gradually begin resuming church activities starting with our public, corporate worship services. Here is some information that will be helpful for you.

1. Anyone **at greater risk** from COVID19 or anyone **not comfortable meeting together** is encouraged to remain at home and participate by watching the ServiceCasts until you are comfortable gathering publicly.
2. We will be holding only our morning and evening worship services at 9:30 AM and 6:00 PM respectively.
  - Please enter the church building through the main doors.
  - Please exit the church building through the kitchen doors except if you have a need to use the Accessible Entrance (main doors).
  - Please enter the sanctuary through the side doors and exit through the center doors.
  - Please sit in a pew together as families. Please use the same pew during the second service you used during the morning service.
  - Every other pew will be closed.
  - There will be no Sunday School classes, Fellowship Meals or Lord's Supper for now.
  - There will be no coffee, drinks, and refreshments served at the church.
  - No nursery care will be provided.
  - The Nursery room will be closed except for diaper changes and nursing mothers.
  - Parents with young children, please keep your children with you at all times inside the church building.
  - Tithes and offerings can be placed in the collection plate/box that will be provided.
  - Access to the sound booth is restricted to those who have been asked to be there.
  - The doors at the back of the sanctuary will be kept open during the service to minimize handling.
3. The Trinity Psalters and Bibles have been removed from the pews.
  - Please take a Trinity Psalter Hymnal from the table in the Fellowship Hall for yourself and your family.
  - If you do not have the Trinity Psalter Hymnal at home they are yours to keep.
  - Be sure to write your name in your Trinity Psalter.
  - Please be sure to bring your Trinity Psalter and Bibles with you every Sunday when you come to worship and take them home with you when you leave.

4. We will continue streaming the ServiceCasts for those who are unable to attend worship services or for those not comfortable meeting together publically for corporate worship.
5. Please **maintain “social distancing” practices** and, as much as possible, socialize outdoors.
  - Everyone is encouraged to **regularly wash their hands** when at the church facilities.
  - Some hand sanitizer is provided at the church, but feel free to bring your own.
6. The Disinfectant Crew will be cleaning following each of the church services.

The session realizes there are differing opinions on how to handle COVID19. Please bear with one another. Out of love for each other please be cautious, thoughtful, gracious, and charitable towards others who think differently about what should or shouldn't be done.
