

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines for responding to the pandemic have changed. The new guidelines are stated on the CDC website as follows:

*“Fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance.*

*You can resume activities without wearing a mask or staying 6 feet apart, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance.”*

With these new guidelines in mind, Park Road Presbyterian Church will now be “mask-optional” at all events and worship services. If you have been vaccinated, this should be the desired and logical next step. If you are not vaccinated and do not wish to be (due to extenuating health concerns or personal conviction etc.) the leadership of Park Road trusts our members to proceed with wisdom, love for others and good stewardship over their own health (Romans 15.14). Anyone wishing to wear a mask may do so without fear of judgment. Socially distanced seating will be available on request.
