Now three days after Festus had arrived in the province from Caesarea. <sup>2</sup> And the chief priests and the principal men of the Jews laid a case against Paul, and they urged him, <sup>3</sup> asking as a favor of him to be sent to Jerusalem—because they were planning a way. <sup>4</sup> Festus replied that Paul was being kept at Caesarea, and intended to go there shortly. <sup>5</sup> "So," said he, "let the king write down with me, and if there is anything wrong about your case against him, I will send him down with me. After he stayed among them not more than eight days, he took his seat on the next day on the barge. When he had arrived, the Jews who had come around him, bringing many and serious charges against him, <sup>8</sup> Paul argued in his defense, "Neither against the temple, nor against Caesar have I committed anything wrong, as you yourself know very well. <sup>11</sup> If I have committed anything for which I deserve to die, I do not refuse to die. There is nothing to their charges against me, no one can prove me guilty to Caesar."

<sup>12</sup> Then Festus & Carner he had conferred with his council and said to Paul, "Acceptably, then, Caesar you shall go."
